Student Evaluations of Teaching

Formal Student Evaluations of Teaching (SET) will not be collected for the Winter 2020 term, however, instructors may still want to collect feedback on their teaching and course design, or to include in a teaching dossier. The Centre for Teaching and Learning has developed three adaptable templates, from which instructors can add or remove questions, and for use in Qualtrics. Feedback can be collected electronically and anonymously. More information is available on the CTL Resource website.

Academic Integrity

Academic dishonesty is a common concern. Some key strategies for mitigating this include designing assignments that are difficult to plagiarize; building collaboration and research into the assignment design; ensuring expectations are clear; and explaining the value of academic integrity to students. Some instructors may also want to employ Academic Honour Codes, which may be as simple as having students attach a verification that their assignment or test is their own original work.
